1. All applicants must have a 3.0 cumulative GPA and submit a copy of their high school transcript.
2. All applicants must be graduating seniors of the Class of 2020.
3. All applicants must have a letter of acceptance from the college/university they are planning to attend and must be enrolling for Fall 2020 semester.
4. Scholarship recipients must provide an Enrollment Verification from their college/university once they have registered for classes.
5. In the event of any withdrawal from the college/university, scholarship recipients will be required to pay back GSSA for all monies received.
6. Deadline for applications is July 31<sup>st</sup>. NO EXCEPTIONS

## The GSSA Scholarship Rules

The GSSA Scholarship recognizes an outstanding high school senior who has been accepted to a four year college/university.

The scholarship award is \$1200.00.

Requirements for the scholarship:

- Completed application;
- Active membership in the Georgia Skeet Shooting Association;
- Georgia Resident;
- Copy of enrollment verification form from college/university showing enrollment for 2020;
- Applicants must have shot at least 500 registered targets in the prior year;
- A letter of acceptance from an accredited college/university;
- A letter of recommendation from an active GSSA member.

If the recipient withdraws from college during the 2020-21 academic year the scholarship funds must be returned to the GSSA within 30 days of withdrawal.

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
